Organizational Meeting

The organizational meeting of the Apple Valley Woodturners was held Saturday, Dec. 1, at the home of Dick Krehling in Winchester. Ten people, interested in learning more about the club, attended and seven paid dues, at \$20 per year, to create the club.

The group elected Dick Krehling as president; David Pye of Marshall, Va., as treasurer and Robert Van Meter, Mt. Falls, Va., as newsletter editor.

The club members selected the first Saturday of every month as meeting day, and the time will be 9 a.m. The meetings will be held at Krehling's home until a suitable site is found. Krehling and Van Meter looked at one site in December and will be checking another before the January meeting date. The club needs a site which is large enough for the membership and where woodworking tools can be set up and used for practice and demonstrations.

During the meeting, each member introduced himself and gave a brief description of his woodworking experience and current interest in working with the lathe. A few people, with no woodturning experience, had the opportunity to take up tool and try turning beads and coves on Krehling's equipment.

Krehling has purchased a mini-lathe, which can be transported to the meetings for the demonstrations and practice sessions.

The members voted on the name of the club, Apple Valley Woodturners, and Krehling will work on a logo.

The Club will affiliate with the American Association of Woodturners. Being an affiliate of the AAW will provide benefits in terms of insurance for any future events and will entitle members to some group discounts on tools and supplies. We will have more information on this in a latter newsletter.
